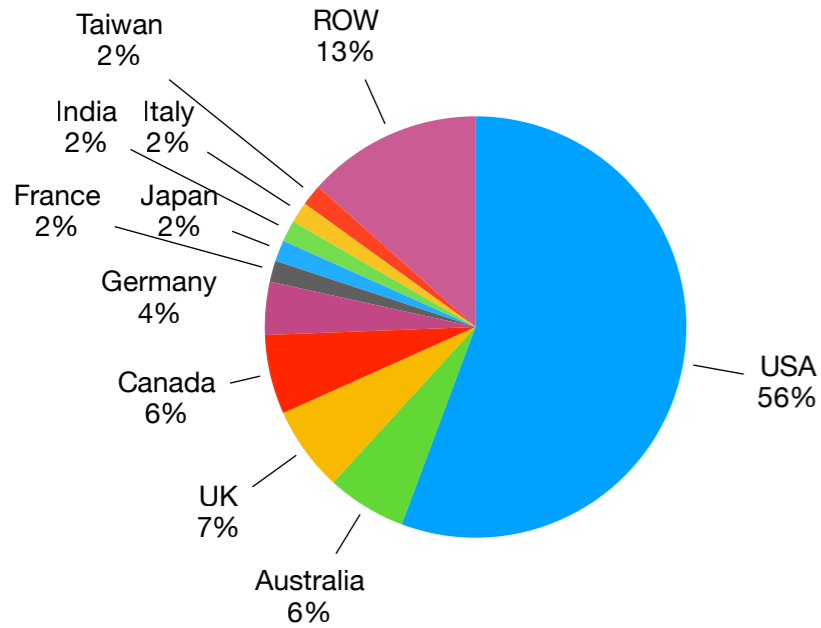
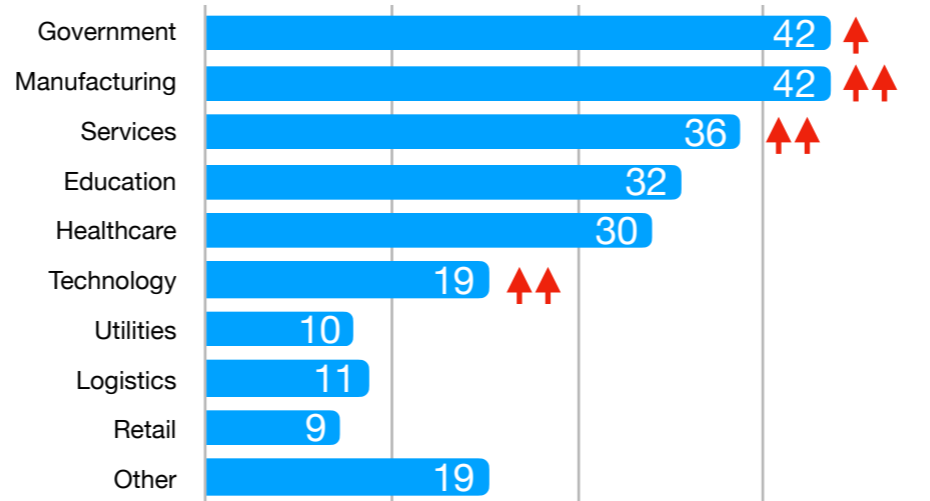

Attacks by Country



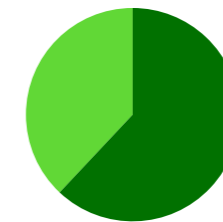

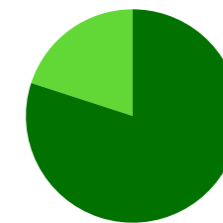

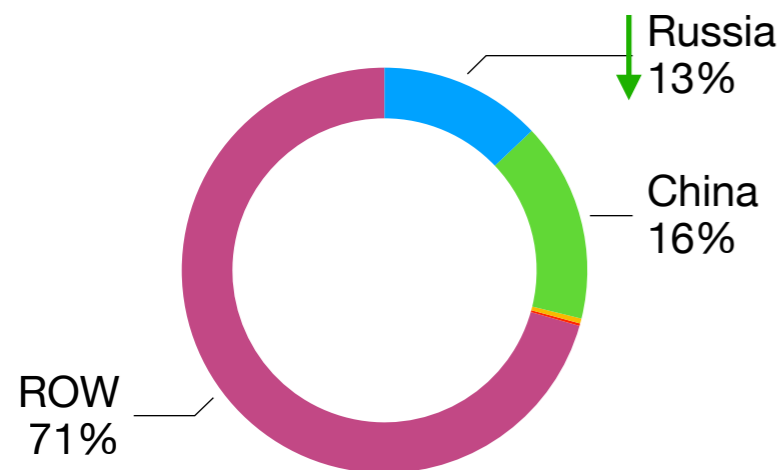

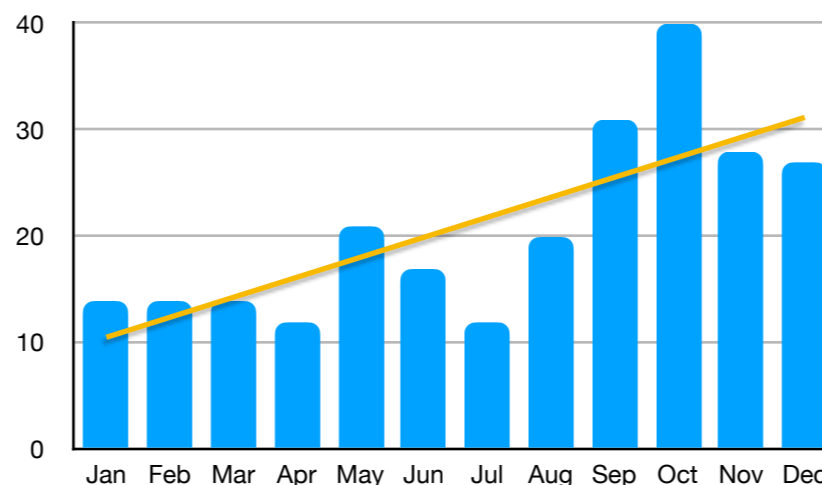

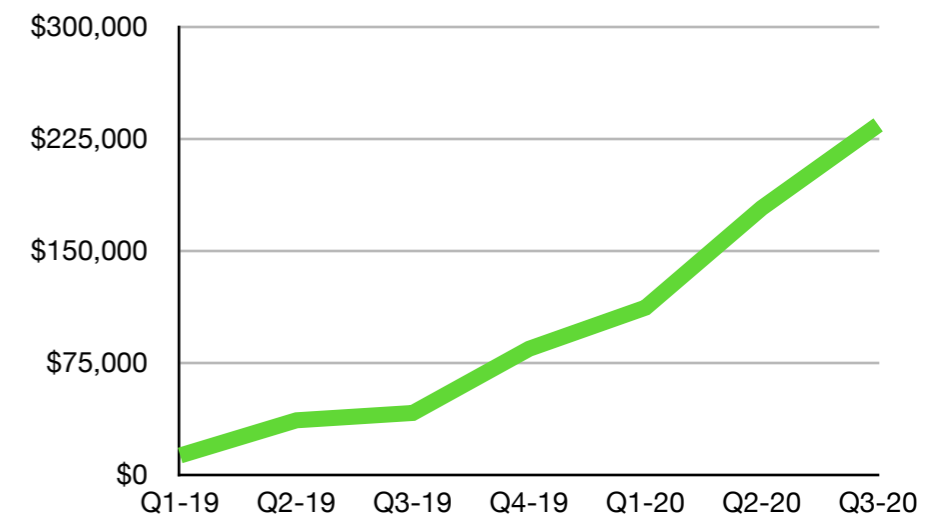
Ransomware Exfiltration



Attack Trend by Month

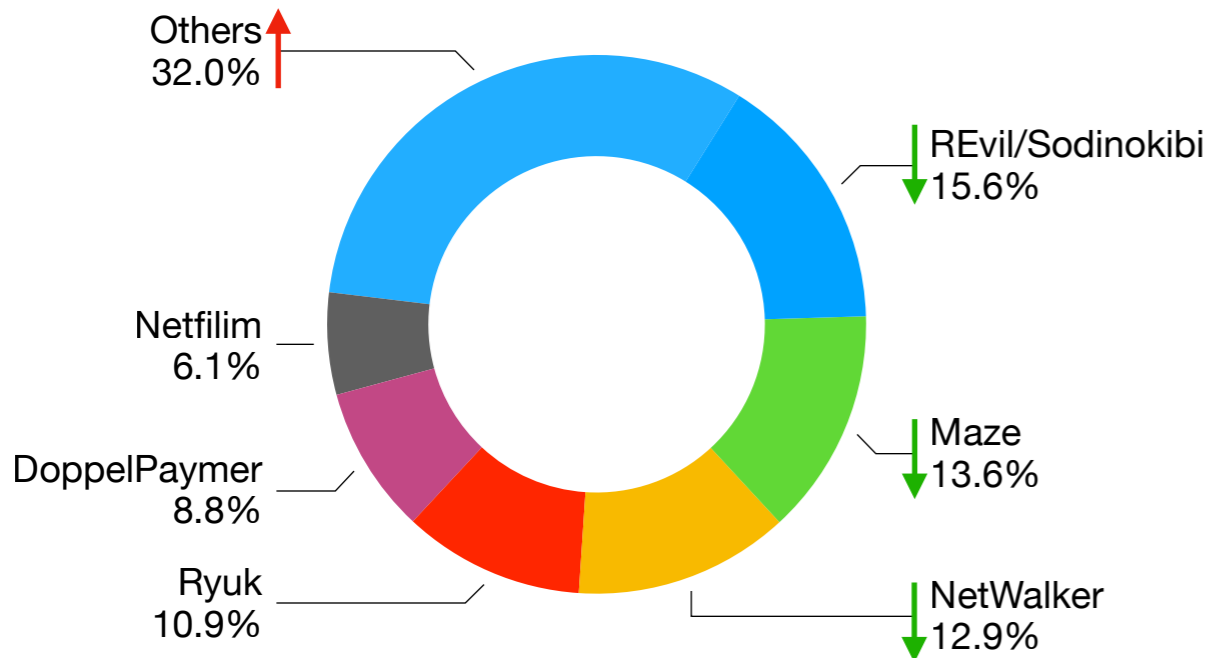


Average Ransom Payout¹

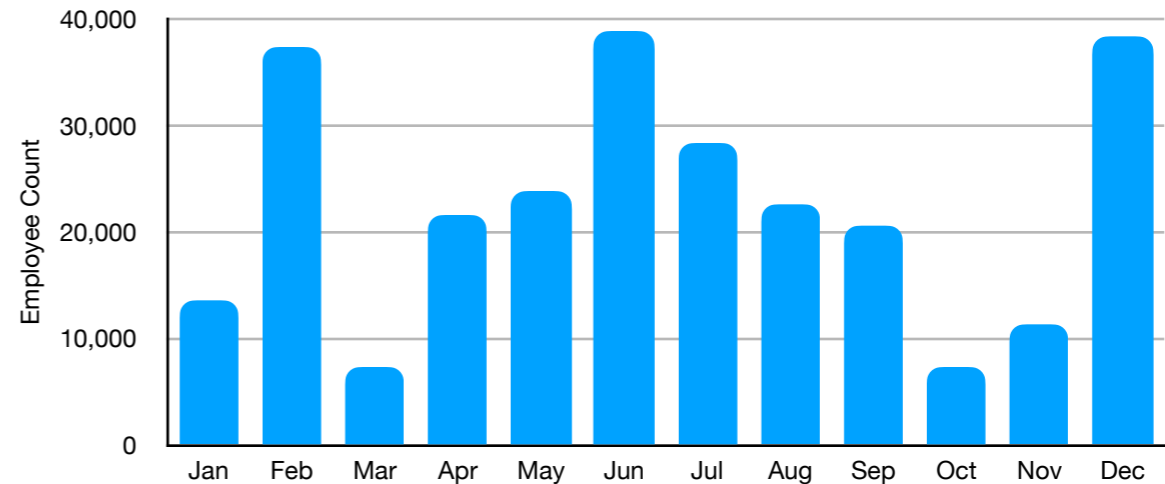

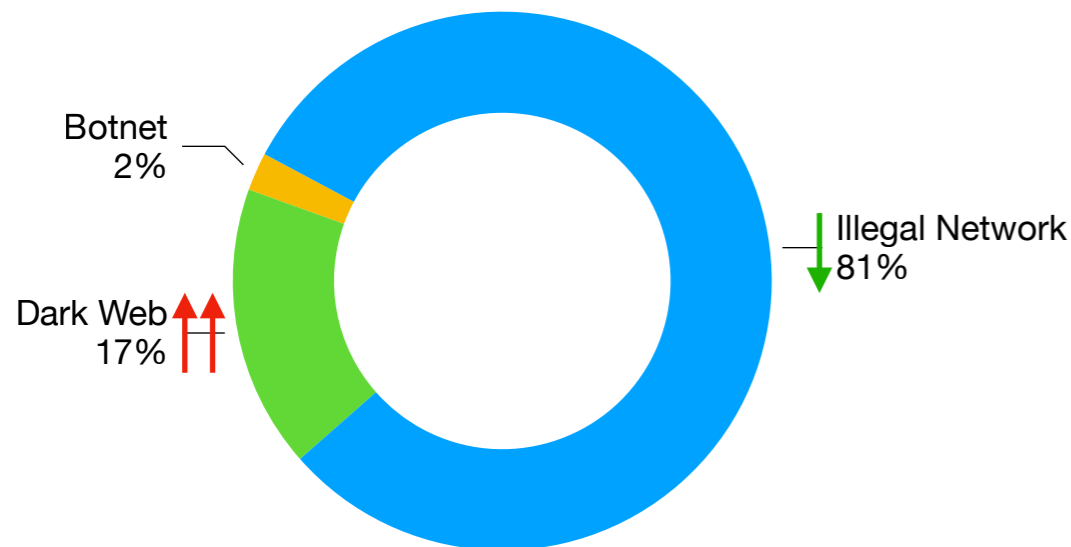
Threats by Variant



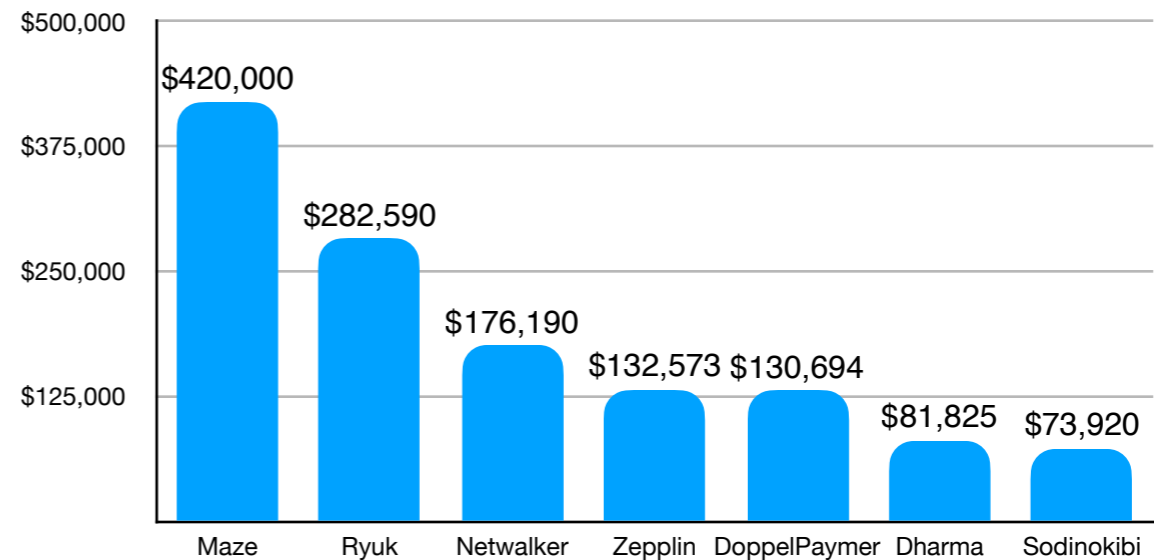
Average Size of Organization
